
STANDING ORDER

Unless otherwise directed, all cases arising out of appeals to overweight or oversize citations that are assigned to Judge Teate are scheduled at the Office of State Administrative Hearings (OSAH) at 225 Peachtree St. N.E., Suite 400, Atlanta, GA. The Department of Public Safety's (DPS) legal representative and any party who wants to make a personal appearance shall report as directed in a notice of hearing to OSAH.

Alternatively, any party and all of DPS's officers who reside outside the Atlanta area are expressly authorized to appear by telephone without necessity of filing a motion to allow such an appearance. Further, please note:

- A party must notify the court and the opposing party that the party wishes to appear by telephone at least 7 days prior to the scheduled hearing and provide the telephone number in writing where the party can be reached;
- The parties are directed to exchange copies of any exhibits they intend to submit to the Court prior to the scheduled hearing;
- DPS's counsel may provide a telephone number for its officers at the time of the hearing; and
- A party requesting telephone appearance and any witness appearing by telephone must remain available to receive a call for up to two hours from the time indicated on the notice of hearing. These cases are scheduled with other such cases and will be called in the order in which they appear on the Judge's calendar.
