OSAH Hearing Updates – last updated March 26, 2020

March 26-31:

<u>ALL</u> hearings (both by telephone and in-person) have been cancelled. This is for every hearing location in all counties of Georgia. Rescheduling orders and notices will be sent out by mail.

April 1-30:

All <u>in-person</u> hearings have been cancelled. This is for every hearing location in all counties of Georgia. Rescheduling orders and notices will be sent out by mail.

However, hearings previously set for April to be conducted by telephone or video shall proceed as scheduled.

May and beyond:

Judges will manage their individual calendars.
